

Where does the event happen ?

A. Event will take place at 26325 Halsted Road, Farmington Hills, Michigan 48331. It is in the Greater Detroit area, Closest airport is DTW (Detroit)

Q. What time does the event start ?

A. Event will start at on Monday, July 8, 2019 at 7:15 AM

Q. Is there a dress code ?

A. Please dress appropriately while visiting this place of worship (No shorts, short jeans, hats, etc. inside the temple).

Q. Is there Wi-Fi. Please provide password ?

A. There is no WiFi availability at the event.

Q. Is food served or do we have to bring our own ?

A. YES! Food is available for all devotees. SVBF is a 100% Vegetarian Site

Q. Can we register / buy tickets on spot?

A. It is open and free for all. Registration is suggested to ensure proper food planning

Q. How does parking works? What are the charges?

A. There are no charges for the parking. Please note that, during the events overflow parking will be available offsite and shuttle transportation arrangements will be made. This app will be updated with detail information on parking as the event nears

Q. Is the Event kids friendly?

A. Yes, the event is kids friendly. SVBF requires that children are always under adult supervision. Children are the responsibility of the parents / guardians and children should not be left unattended throughout the event.

Q. Can we take pictures and videos?

A. Pictures and Videos can be taken in many areas. However due to religious reasons some areas may not be photographed or video-graphed. Signs to that effect will be posted.

Q. Are there places close by for accommodations for out-of-town devotees?

Q. Can we bring Milk, fruits, Flowers, Ghee, etc.? for Pooja or Havan (Homa)?

A. You can bring flowers and fruits as offering. However, milk, ghee and other similar products are not accepted from outside.

Q. Can we bring prasadams (Food) made from home?

A. During Kumbhabhishekam most food for prasadam will be made within the temple premises by special cooks. However, you can work as a volunteer in helping to make prasadams.

Q. When is the main Maha Kumbhabhishekam event?

A. Subha Muhurtam is on Thursday JULY 11, 2019 from 9:45 AM to 10:45 AM Eastern time.
